Are you in COB or CAL? Applying for scholarships has a new look for these two colleges!

In addition to scholarships from the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships, students can now apply for scholarships from the College of Business and the College of Arts & Letters through Madison Scholarships Hub.

To log in, go to MyMadison and under the Student tab click on the logo for Madison Scholarships Hub.



Qualifications for the majority of our scholarships are based on the general application as well as information pulled directly from your student academic record. **Deadlines vary** across departments so be sure to complete the general application as soon as possible to receive full consideration.

Review the criteria for any recommended scholarship opportunity you are presented with and if you meet the qualifications, click apply to submit additional required information.

To receive priority consideration for 2020-21 financial aid, submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before **March 1**, JMU's priority filing date.
